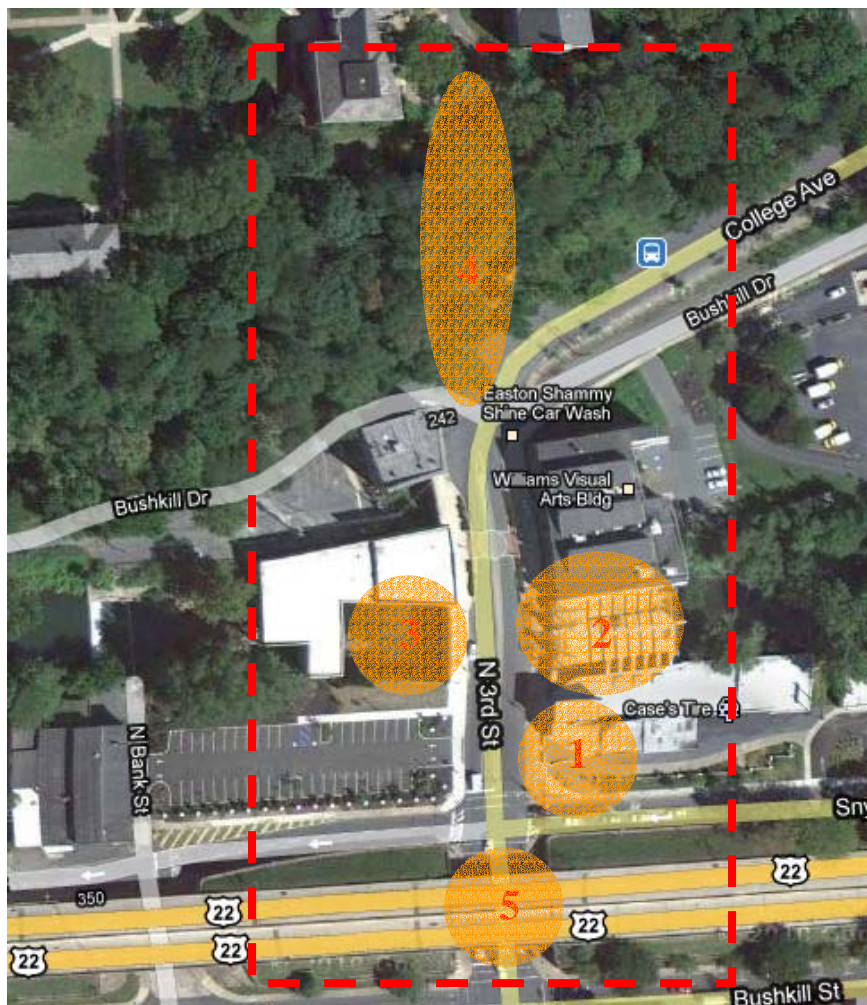
ROUTE I.

BUSHKILL CORRIDOR

The Lafayette Arts Campus (North Third Street) to the Route 22 interchange of North 13th Street

Cluster A: Lafayette College Arts Campus

- Lafayette College's expanded arts campus for painting, sculpture, digital media, film, and theater
- Part of the new Bushkill Corridor greenway
- Prone to flooding from the Delaware River
- Route 22 cut this area and the College Hill residential area off from Downtown Easton in the 1930s
- The site of water-powered mills since the late-18th century, renovated late-19th and early-20th century industrial and commercial buildings sit on or near a 19th-century arched stone bridge



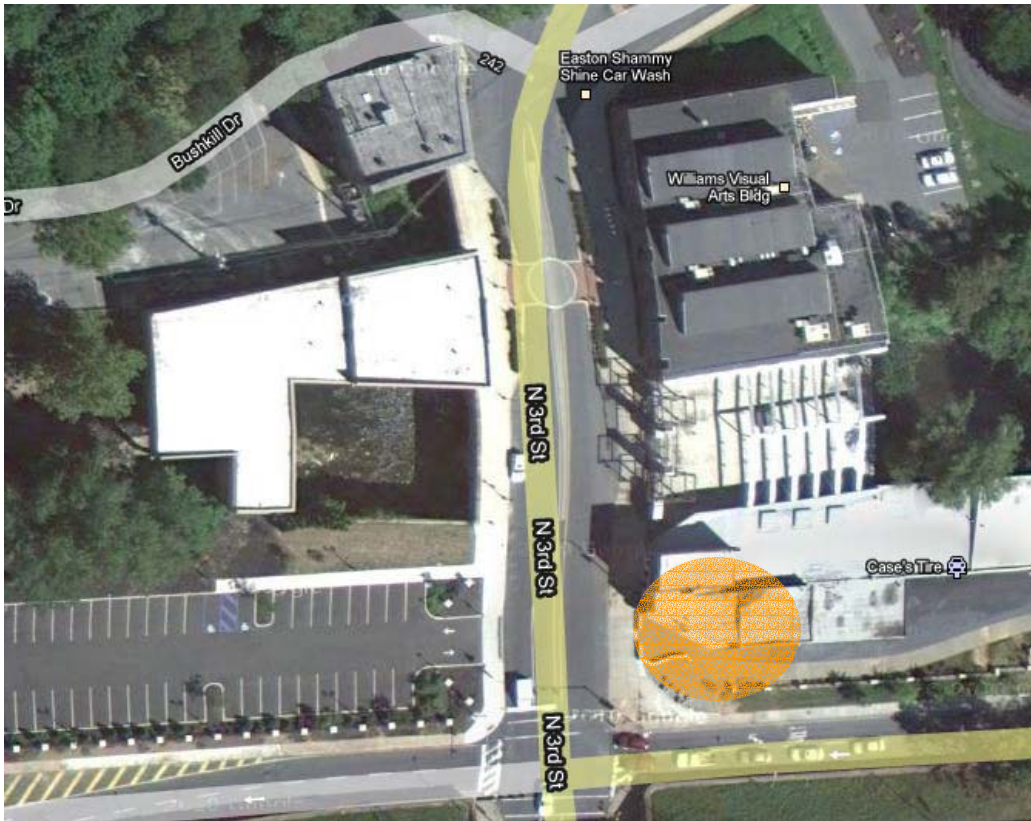

Arts Campus (Sign Post), 219 North Third Street (Lafayette College)



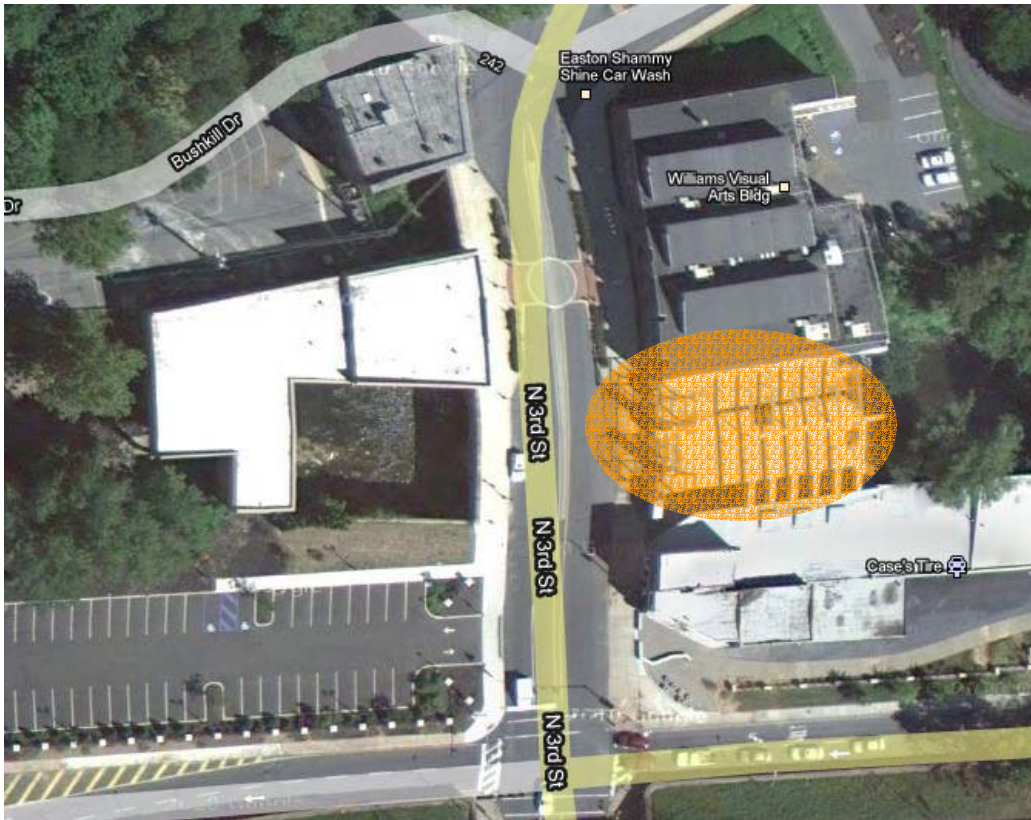

Arts Campus (Arts Plaza), 223 North Third Street (Lafayette College)



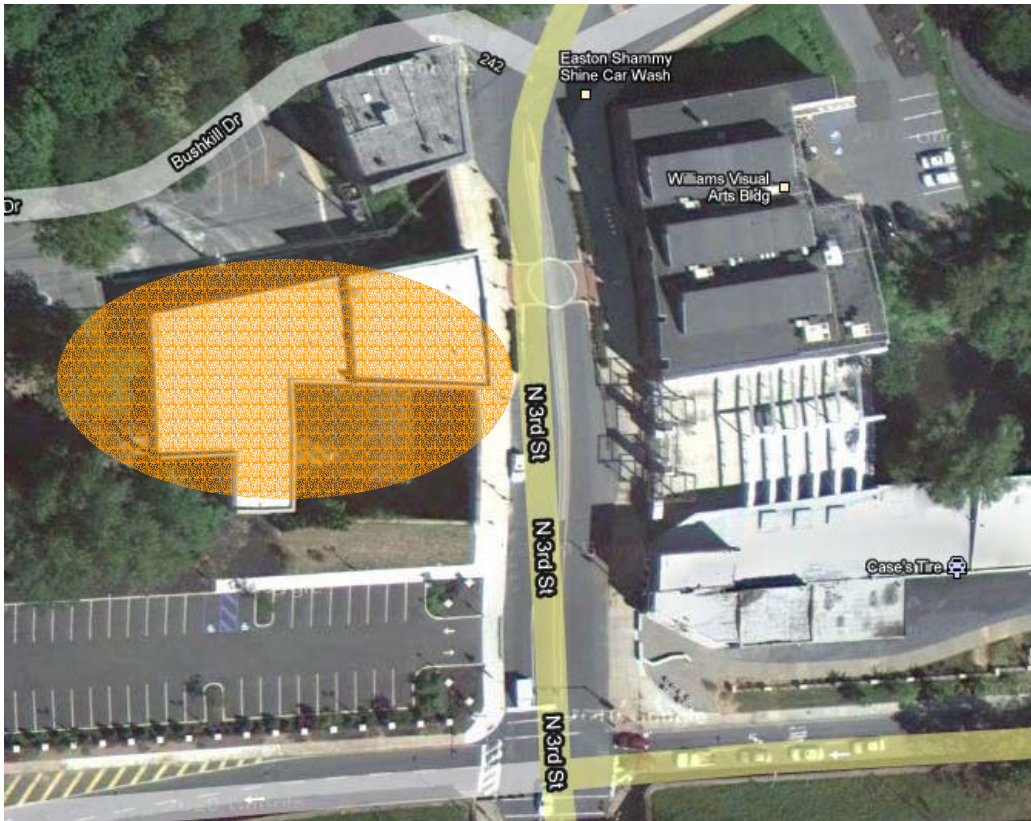

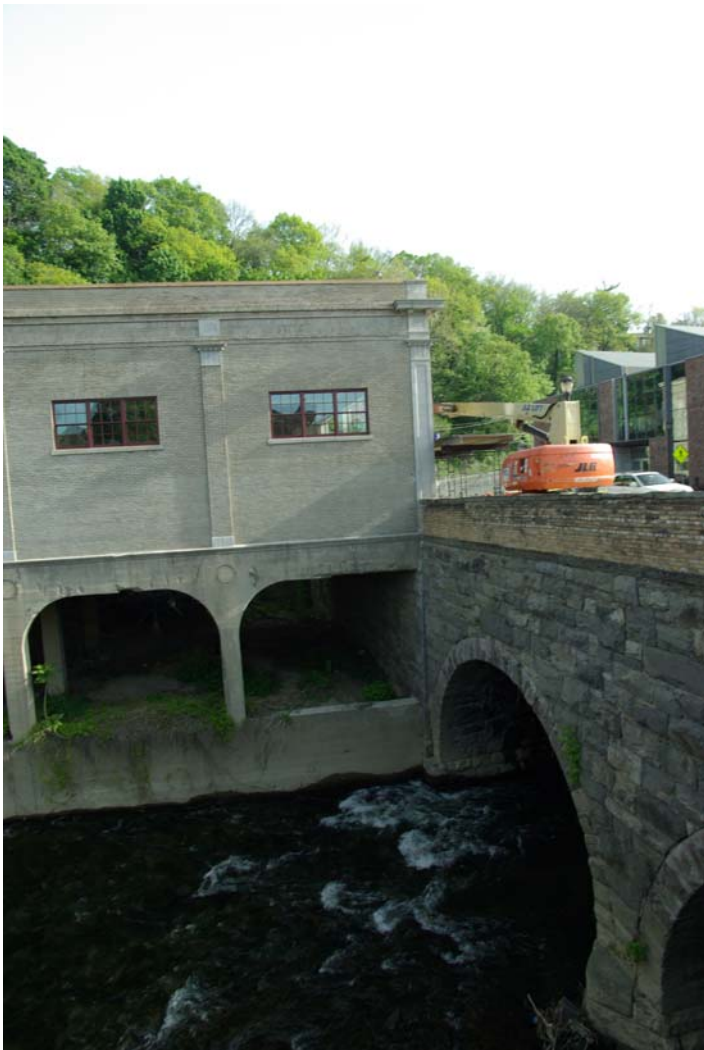

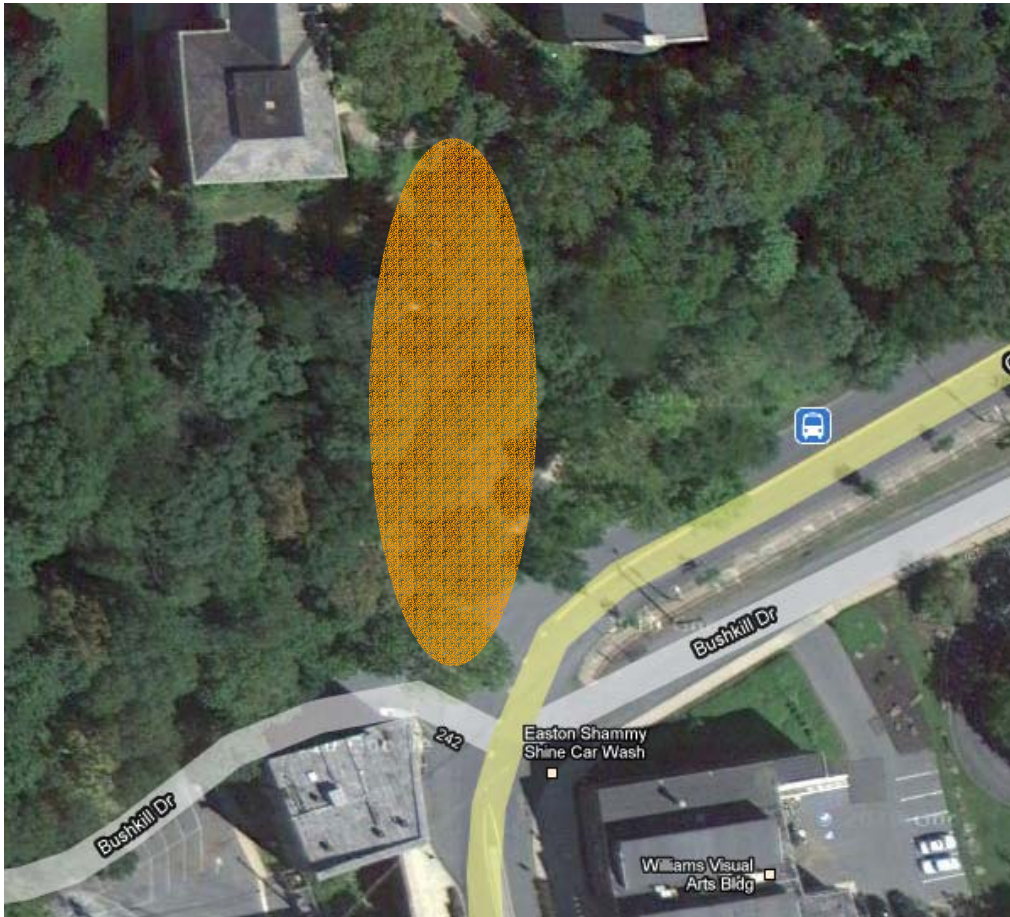
