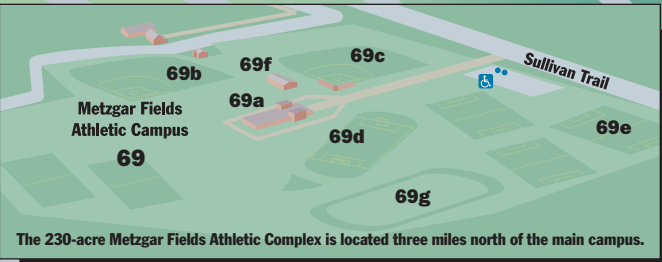


Campus Map

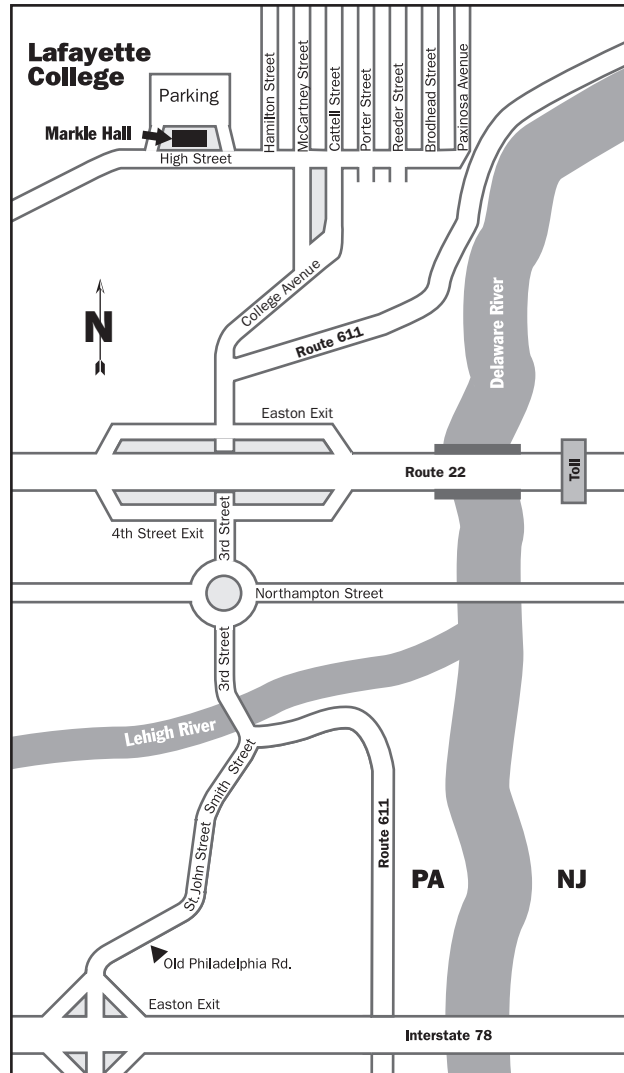

Come for a visit: Student-led campus tours are available without appointment Monday through Friday throughout the year and on most Saturday mornings when classes are in session, but are on limited schedules during holiday seasons and vacation periods. Please call the Office of Admissions for information.

Lafayette is just off Route 22 in Easton, at the Delaware River boundary between Pennsylvania and New Jersey. The bus station is a 15-minute walk from campus. Lehigh Valley International Airport is off Route 22 about 20 minutes from campus; Newark International is 60 minutes away via Route I-78.

How to schedule an interview: Personal interviews are scheduled Monday through Friday from May 1 through Dec. 30. Group sessions occur on selected weekdays throughout the year and on most Saturday mornings when classes are in session. To make an appointment, please call the Office of Admissions two to four weeks prior to the proposed date.

Directions to Lafayette

From Route 22 East/Interstate 78 East: (shorter route) Exit I-78 onto Route 22 (heading toward Pa. Turnpike, LVI airport/Whitehall), follow Route 22 for about 20 miles to Easton. Take the Fourth Street exit. Bear left at the end of the exit ramp at light. Go one block to Third Street, turn left, and travel under Route 22 overpass. Third Street turns into College Avenue. Follow "Entering Campus" below.

From Interstate 78 East: Take the "Easton exit," the last one in Pennsylvania. Turn left at the end of the exit ramp and follow signs for Route 611 North. This road becomes Third Street and takes you halfway around the circle in the center of downtown Easton. Continue on Third Street, which becomes College Avenue—a steep hill leading up to the college entrance. Follow "Entering Campus" below.

From Interstate 78 West: When you cross the New Jersey/Pennsylvania border, you will go through a toll booth area. Take the "Easton exit," the first one in Pennsylvania. Turn right at the end of the exit ramp and follow signs for Route 611 North. This road becomes Third Street and takes you halfway around the circle in the center of downtown Easton. Continue on Third Street, which becomes College Avenue—a steep hill leading up to the college entrance. Follow "Entering Campus" below.

From Route 22 West: Exit Interstate 78 at Route 22 (Alpha, N.J., Exit 3). Proceed through Phillipsburg and across the bridge leading into Easton. Stay to the right and take the Easton exit, the second right after the bridge. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto College Avenue—a steep hill leading up to the college entrance. Follow "Entering Campus" below.

Entering Campus: At the top of the hill, turn left on McCartney Street. At the first stop sign, turn left on High Street. After the stop sign, take the next right turn onto the parking deck, located behind Markle Hall. The Admissions Reception Area is on the first floor of Markle Hall.

Visitor Parking: Please park in the deck behind Markle Hall. Several visitor and handicapped spaces are available in front of Markle. We appreciate your cooperation since all other spaces are assigned to Lafayette students, faculty, or staff.
