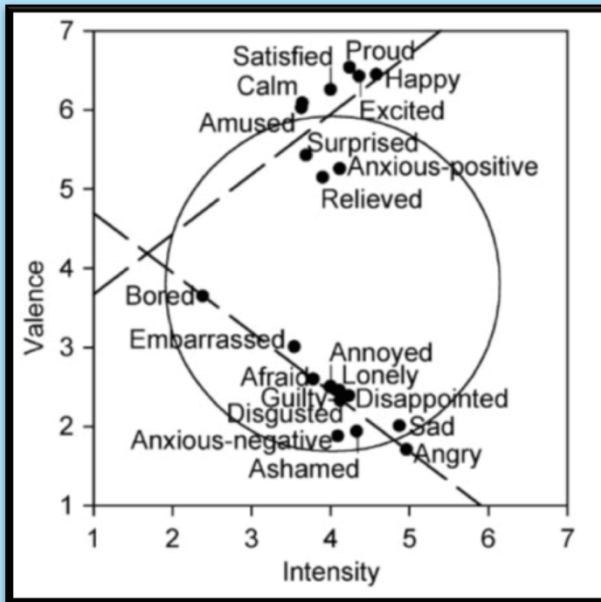

"I think it's a way of thinking about the world and being very pragmatic"

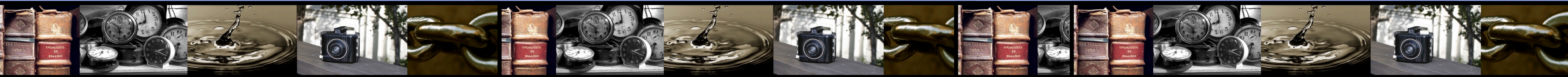
Short Term Store (Current Work)

Long Term Store (Childhood)

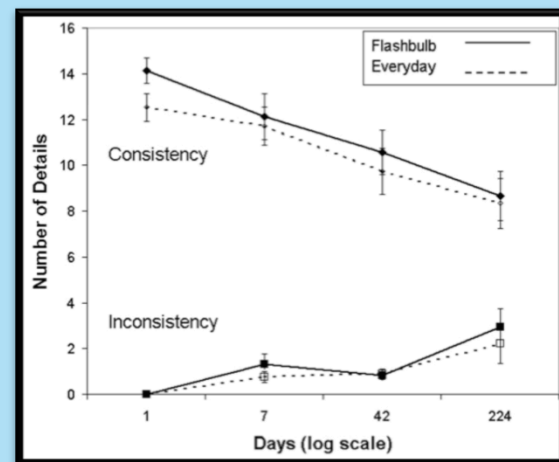

*** Flashbulb Memory are not as reliable as previously believed**



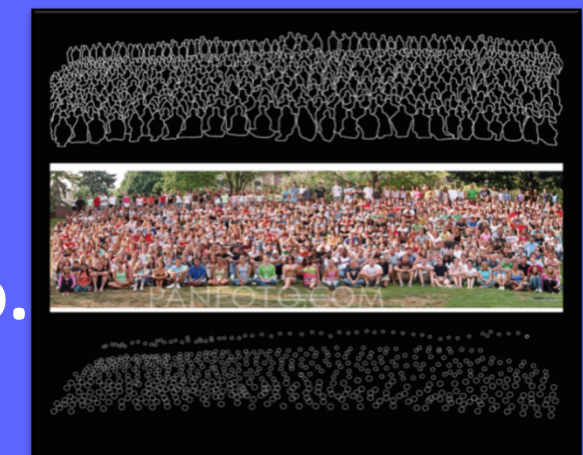
Episodic Buffer (Mentorship)
