



U.S.-China Tariffs Overview

- Continued momentum with talks, preliminary agreement with China called "phase 1" of potential deal
- Agreement calls for doubling U.S. annual agricultural exports to China while addressing some Chinese foreign-exchange issues.
- Has halted scheduled tariff increases, benefitting China
- Concerns of increased tension if agreement fails




U.S.-China Tariffs Continued

- Still uncertain if deal will be made
- Possible Chinese wait until next election or longer
- Overall, positive outlook for rebalancing trade relationship




Intercontinental Exchange (ICE)

- Founded in 2000 by Jeff Sprecher
- Provides trading infrastructure in major market centers around the world, offering customers the ability to manage risk and make informed decisions in the jurisdictions and asset classes of their choice
- Fortune 500 and 9th largest company in capital markets industry by market capitalization (\$52 Billion)

2001: Enron Implodes, ICE soars

- Founder and ICE CEO approached Enron to be a client of ICE's online marketplace for energy trading
- Enron instead started its own competing electricity trading platform that dominated the market
- Enron filed for Ch. 11 bankruptcy on 12/2/2001
- Flood of former Enron clients searched for other ways to trade electricity and natural gas and found ICE platform



ICE's Business Segments

- Divided into two segments
 - Trading and Clearing
 - Accounts for 49% of revenue
 - Data and Listings
 - Accounts for 51% of revenue



ICE's Business Segments


- Trading and Clearing
 - Operates 12 regulated exchanges and six clearing houses located in major market centers around the world, including the U.S., U.K., European Union, Canada and Singapore.
 - Examples include New York Stock Exchange, ICE Clear Europe, and ICE Clear USA


ICE's Business Segments

 - Data and listings segment is largely **subscription based**

- Chairman of the Board since Nov. 2002




- 110th largest company on S&P 500
