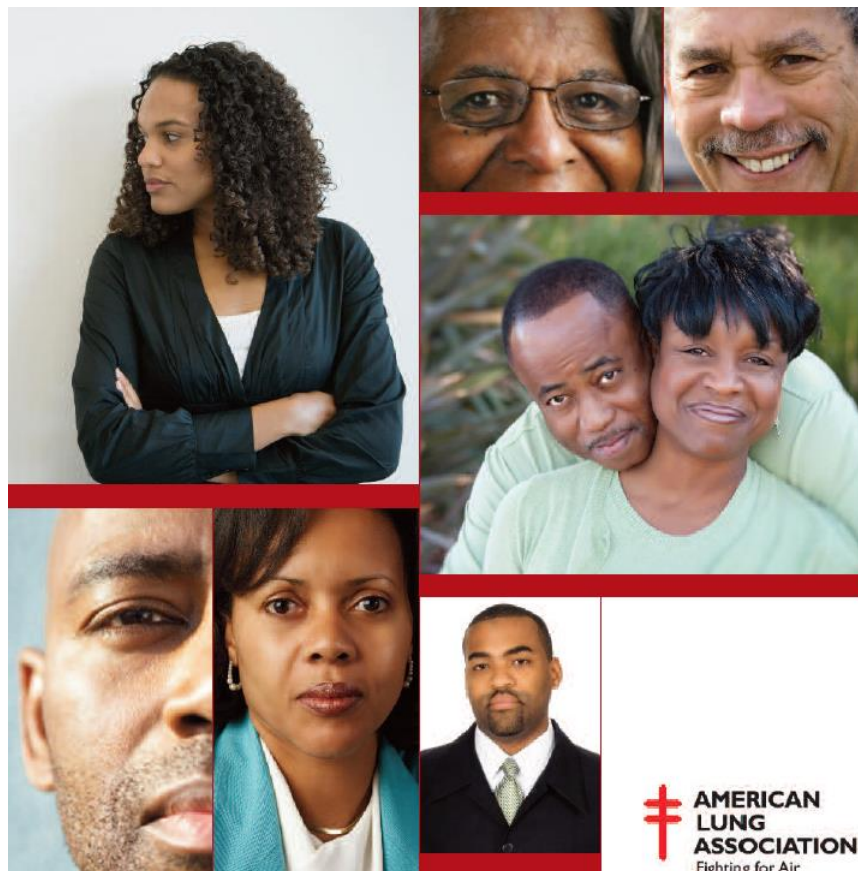


Predicting drug response, radon exposure, and lung cancer: What's race got to do with it?
