Director's Message

Dear High School Instrumental Music Families:

We are beginning to approach the end of the school year and the weather is beginning to show signs of summer. With this warm weather coming, we still have a full schedule with jazz festivals, performances, concerts, a parade, and so much more.

Before looking to April, I would like to reflect on the month of March and how much our students have accomplished. We began the month with a highly successful musical showing of "Oklahoma." Hopefully you had the opportunity to see so many of our students in the pit, on stage, and behind the scenes. In addition, we had 33 of our students represent Easton at County Band this year at Freedom High School on March 16 and had two students represent our school and themselves at PMEA regional festivals. One student will continue on to perform in the All-State ensembles the first week of April. Additionally, two of our jazz students represented Easton at the District Jazz Festival held at Wilson Area High School this past weekend. Finally, our jazz band had a great festival in Scotch Plains New Jersey and we began our color guard audition rehearsals throughout the month.

Looking ahead to April, we have another busy month as we prepare for the end of the year. We will begin our drum major clinics for any interested students, in addition to hold color guard auditions to begin to form next year's group. Our marching band percussionists will continue rehearsing throughout the month to prepare for our Spring Band Concert and the Memorial Day Parade.

Our EAHS Jazz Festival will be held on Saturday, April 13. There are over ten local bands performing at this event, which will make for a great night of jazz. The event begins at 5:30 PM with our EAMS Jazz Band and the night will conclude with awards following our EAHS Jazz Ensemble. In addition, our jazz band will also be performing at three events this month, including the EASD Prom Fashion Show on April 5, the Neshaminy Jazz Festival on April 26 and the Pocono Mountain East Festival on Saturday, April 27.

Our 10-12 orchestras continue to prepare for our PMEA Adjudication on Friday, April 26, held at East Stroudsburg North High School. This adjudication will assess our student ensembles on prepared music, as well

as our sight reading skills. It will be a great learning experience right before our Spring Concert on Friday, May 3.

Please continue to check our online calendar at www.eahsmusic.org for up to date events. Your students continue to amaze me in their dedication to the music program and the improvements and progress we have made as a group since the beginning of the year.

Join us for our next IMA meeting on Tuesday, April 9 beginning at 7:00 PM in the EAHS Cafeteria. These meetings are valuable opportunities to get involved in our program and continue to provide the best experiences to every child.

Our Shop with Scrip fundraiser is in full swing. In the two weeks since we began the program, our IMA families have raised almost \$500 towards their fundraising goals with one family reaching almost \$80.

Don't miss out on this easy way to help reach your student's fundraising goal. Now is the perfect time to get started or to have other family members and friends get involved. Anyone can do it and it doesn't matter where you live. Since we all spend money on gas, food, and clothes, why not earn some fundraising money in the process?

I would strongly recommend using the online, Presto Pay, in order to receive your orders more quickly. However, if you are paying by check, they can be sent in to school or can be dropped off on Thursday nights.

Fall CRAFT SHOW INFORMATION SHEET SATURDAY, November 16, 2019 9:00 AM – 2:00 PM

- 1. Spaces are approximately 10 ft. frontage x 5 ft. deep. This could vary slightly if your space is in the hallway. The cost is **\$40.00** per space without electric **\$45.00** with electric.
- 2. YOU MUST BRING YOUR OWN TABLES AND CHAIRS.
- **3.** Applications are accepted on a first come, first serve basis. Please submit your payment early to avoid disappointment.
- 4. Any special request on application is filled on a **first-come/first serve** basis and is **NOT** guaranteed.
- 5. Check <u>must</u> accompany your application. **Please make check payable to "IMA". We do NOT mail confirmations**. Mail applications to:

- 6. We <u>try</u> to maintain some distance between crafters/vendors with the same or similar items. However, because some sellers offer multiple types of items (for example, floral and wood items), it is not always possible to separate applicants as far apart as desired.
- 7. Please do not ask to set-up the night before the show or earlier than 7:00 AM on show day.
- 8. The IMA reserves the right to not accept any crafter/vendor application.
- 9. The Craft Show is a <u>fundraiser</u> for the IMA. We are a nonprofit 501 3C and **can not give REFUNDS.** We can apply your payment to the next show.

ON SHOW DAY:

- 1. We will have volunteers to assist you with off-loading at 7:00 AM. They will also be available at 2:00 PM to assist with packing items. **You are not allowed to breakdown before 2:00 PM**.
- 2. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER THE BUILDING BEFORE 7:00 AM.
- 3. Check-in time is 7:00-8:30 AM at the IMA tables in the hallway. Upon arrival, please signin with us **before** you begin your set-up. At that time, you will receive:
 - a. Your space assignment
 - b. Menu/prices for our food court (please see application to indicate if you need a volunteer to bring lunch to your space).

- c. One coupon for a free hot drink and doughnut per purchased space.
- d. Your numbered display slip for our *Treasure Hunt*. We encourage you to participate as this brings our patrons to all spaces in search of their matching number. The *Treasure Hunt* also serves as a fundraiser for us to benefit all instrumental music students at EAHS. (See below)
- 4. After unloading, please move your vehicle as far away from the building as is physically possible. This will allow customers to easily enter the building by having parking available close to the building. After all, this is why you are at the show!

<u>Treasure Hunt Rules and Procedures</u>

Instead of a regular raffle for donated craft items, we are holding a "Craft Treasure Hunt". Please take a minute to read the instructions.

When you check in a craft show official will ask if you wish to donate an item. If so, take a "Treasure Hunt Prize" slip and place it on your display with the item you are donating. **Please** be sure that the prize is suitably visible.

The item <u>must</u> be easily visible to the customer without having to touch or move anything.

When a customer has the ticket with the number matching the same one on your "Treasure Hunt Prize" slip, they may take the item. Have the customer sign the "Treasure Hunt Prize" slip and give this to any volunteer.

You may not assist the customer in locating the item or tell them the ticket number. However, you may tell them if you have a prize or if it has already been won.

Any prize not claimed by the end of the day remains the property of the crafter.

Any substitution of the prize (such as for color or style) is entirely at the discretion of the crafter/vendor.
