Director's Message

Dear High School Instrumental Music Families:

Another month has gone by and we have had many events within our Instrumental Music program. We held our 28th annual jazz festival on Saturday, April 13th, hosting nine schools during a great night of jazz. Our jazz band also completed our competition season with two back-to-back festivals at Neshaminy High School and Pocono Mountain East. We also had a pep band perform at the annual EASD Wall of Fame Induction. Both our Chamber Strings and Symphony Orchestra received superior ratings at a PMEA Adjudication held at East Stroudsburg North High School. Concluding the month, on Monday, April 29, we inducted our second class to the Tri-M Honor Society.

Looking ahead to the month of May, there are numerous events as we look towards the end of the year. All students continue to rehearse at a high level and raise the standard in classes. Our spring orchestra and band concerts will be held on Friday, May 3 and Friday, May 10, respectively. Both concerts begin at 7:00 p.m. in the EAHS Auditorium. Our Spring Wind Ensemble concert will take place on Wednesday, May 22, also beginning at 7:00 p.m. Our Senior Recital will feature six senior students performing solos on their instruments. This event will take place on Wednesday, May 29 beginning at 6:00 p.m. in the auditorium.

We will hold our Saturday Night Swing Event on Saturday May 11 from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. This event is a great night of jazz held in our Instrumental Music Room. Tickets for the event are \$20/ person and can be purchased by emailing myself at ballentinec@eastonsd.org or reaching me via phone at (610) 250 2481 x 32214. Hor D'oeuvres and mock tails will be served while listening to wonderful jazz music. Please consider coming out and supporting our program at this event.

Our marching band will perform at the Memorial Day Parade on Monday, May 27. This parade is an important community event as we recognize all those who have given their lives to defend our nation. Details regarding report times will be forthcoming within the next few weeks. We will have three rehearsals to prepare for this parade on May 14, 21 and 23.

In addition to the above events, we will also be hosting our IMA Designer Purse Bingo on May 5 in the EAHS Cafeteria. This is a large fundraiser for our program, so please consider attending if you are able and

interested. We will host our Spring Drive 4 UR School Event on Sunday, May 19. This event is in partnership with Koch 33 Ford. For every vehicle someone test-drives on this day, we receive \$20 towards our program, up to a total of \$6,000! This is a huge opportunity for us to reach our fundraising goals.

On Saturday, June 1, we will reflect and end our year together with our Instrumental Music Banquet. Every student in the program is encouraged to attend this evening as we recognize the accomplishments of our students throughout the past year. They have accomplished so much together – it is a great night and way to end the year. Dinner will be served and awards will be presented.

Thursday, June 13 2:00 – 8:30 p.m. Friday, June 14 9:00 – 3:30 p.m.




Mr. Hannum has long been regarded as one of the nation's foremost percussion arrangers, instructors, and clinicians having presented numerous seminars and workshops throughout the United States, Canada, Europe, and Southeast Asia. He is known internationally for his work with the DCI World Champion Cadets of Bergen County and Star of Indiana. Thom is also a charter member of the design team for the Tony Award-winning show Blast!

In the summer of 2001, Mr. Hannum was selected for induction into the Drum Corps International Hall of Fame. He is also a member of the Hall of Fame for the Cadets of Bergen County, and the Crossmen Drum & Bugle Corps. Thom is a product consultant and clinician for the Avedis Zildjian Cymbal Company, Evans Drum Heads, the Pearl Corporation, and Vic Firth Sticks & Mallets where he has developed several Signature Series drumsticks and keyboard mallets. He is an active member of the Percussive Arts Society where he has served on the Marching Percussion Committee for 12 years.
